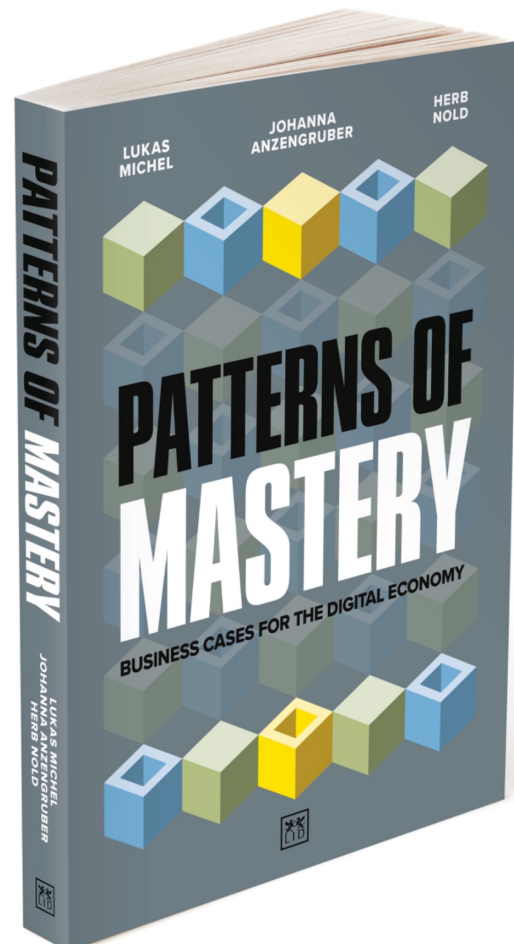

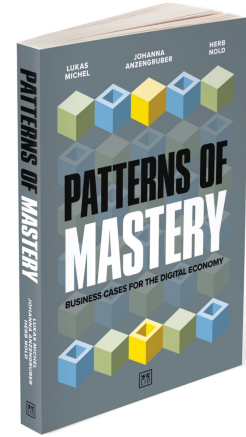

## Themes That Run Through the Book

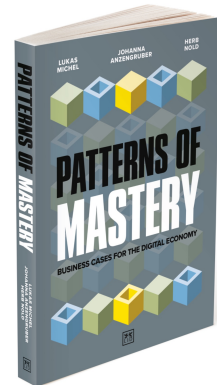
- 1 PATTERNS**

- 3 CONTEXT**  
Mastery never exists in the abstract. It is shaped by industry, market conditions, technology, and organizational history. 
- 4 PATHWAYS**  
Organizations do not all reach mastery in the same way. Different paths can lead to strong outcomes. 
- 5 PRACTICE**  
The book connects ideas to real business cases, making the themes concrete and discussable.
